

## **Downtown Sprinkler Assistance Program**

This program is designed to encourage the redevelopment of Enid's historic downtown buildings for commercial use by offsetting a portion of the cost to install fire suppression sprinklers in the building.

Eligible Applicants: Buildings located within the boundaries of Main Street Enid. Between the Railroad Track and Adams (east to west) and Elm and Owen K Garriott (north to south). Subject to Board approval.

Eligible Costs: Installation of the exterior fire line

Award Amount: Reimbursement of 100% of costs not to exceed \$10,000. Paid upon receipt of the Certificate of Occupancy from the City of Enid.

### Application Requirements:

To qualify for reimbursement, approval must be received by the ERDA Board prior to beginning the installation.

Include at least 2 bids for the cost of installing the exterior fire line to the building.

Complete the ERDA Funding Application which includes:

- A copy of the business plan
- Business financials and 1-year proforma
- 3 professional references
- W-9

### Process for Approval

Applications will be reviewed by the ERDA at the next ERDA Board meeting.
