ENID, OKLAHOMA

HIGHWAY



Located in North Central Oklahoma, Enid is serviced by four-lane divided US Highways 60, 412, 64 and 81. Interstate 35 is 28 miles east of Enid, and Interstate 40 is 60 miles south of Enid. The Cimarron Turnpike (US60 and US412) extends from Tulsa and the Arkansas River Navigation System to the Northwest Passage (Oklahoma City to Colorado corridor). US Highway 81 stretches from Kansas to Texas paralleling, and providing relief for, I-35.

RAIL



Two major rail carriers, Burlington Northern/Santa Fe and Union Pacific, provide effective service to and from Enid, linking the area to the west coast, the Pacific Rim, and Mexico.

AIR



The Woodring Regional Airport is an all-weather, tower controlled, instrument landing facility with an 8,000-foot runway. Businesses located in the airport industrial park benefit from the Foreign Trade Zone designation and the direct access to the taxiway. In 2019, Woodring also constructed a new terminal.

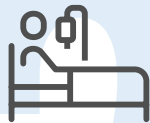
